

The purpose of this project is a complete street rehabilitation of Main Street, which includes full upgrades to pedestrian, bicycle, and transit accommodations in keeping with the City's 2014 Master Plan - Sustainable Greenfield and Complete Streets Prioritization Plan adopted in 2017. The project will address safety at pedestrian and bicycle accident clusters on Main Street, bring infrastructure into a state of good repair, and upgrade the intersection design of Main Street at High Street. The project will enhance the experience of Main Street and compliment development potential.





Project Goals Curb to Curb:

Improvements being considered:

- Creating safer intersections and calming vehicle speeds
- Ensuring the accessibility of all sidewalks and ramps
- Optimizing on-street parking
- Improving public transit service amenities
- Making biking safer and more comfortable
- Improving pedestrian connections and crossing visibility
- Creating connections to citywide bike routes and walking trails
- Ensuring easy and safe connections to public parking just off Main Street

The purpose of this first meeting is to gather input from the public before design concepts are developed. A second community workshop will be scheduled in the Spring of 2023 to present design concept plans and gather feedback before completing the 25% design for MassDOT review.
